Romans 3:23

■ You need to recognize that your sin has separated you eternally before the just and eternal God.

Romans 6:23a

Because the wages of sin is death, ■ You need to understand that your sin comes with a price and it is death or separation from God in a place of eternal damnation.

2

Romans 5:8

But God shows his love for us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. ■ You need to understand what God did for you. Despite being sinners, Christ paid the price that we were to pay.

3

Romans 6:23b

but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. God offers us free the gift of eternal life through the Lord Jesus Christ. We must receive the Son of God, Jesus Christ, to receive the gift of eternal life. ■ You need to give up any attempt to save yourself on your own.

4

How can I receive the gift of salvation?

Romans 10:9-10

that if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Because with the heart one believes for justice, but with the mouth one confesses for salvation.

■ You need to confess that Jesus is the Lord and the only one who can save you from your sins. - You need to confess that Jesus is the Lord and the only one who can save you from your sins. Believe with all your heart that Jesus rose from the dead.

■ The next step is to make you Savior of your life. Talk to Him, and just ask God to save you. God wants you to have a personal relationship with him which begins with receiving his Son Jesus Christ in your heart.

Some words that can serve as a guide:

God, forgive all my sins and save my soul. I regret everything I have done wrong and ask you to change me. Enter my heart, save my soul from eternal damnation. Thank you for sending Jesus to die on the cross, shedding his blood to cleanse me from sin, thank you because he was buried and because he rose again on the third day, proving to be God. I receive you as my personal savior. In the name of Jesus I ask you. Amen.
